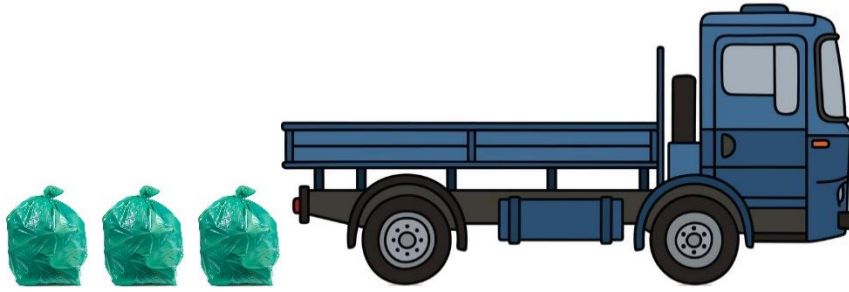


# NAKOMA COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

## 2020 Green Waste Pick-Up Program



**What's Happening:** Nakoma Community Association is sponsoring a Green Waste pick up service.

**When:** May 1 through September 30. Pick up will be during the week when enough accumulation warrants a full truck/trailer load.

**Cost:** \$15 per cubic yard. All yard waste accumulated **must be bagged**.

### **ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS:**

- **Pine needles and cones.**
- **Branches in SMALL PIECES, green yard waste too small to chip.**

**NO ROCKS, DIRT, CONCRETE, ASPHALT, METAL, PAPER OR ANY OTHER ITEM THAT DOES NOT GROW IN YOUR YARD, PLEASE!**

### **Instructions:**

- Pile your bags in an easy to load place next to your driveway.
- The crew will determine how many of your bags = 1 cubic yard.
- They will count the total bags you have.
- If you are there at the time you may pay with CASH or drop cash at the HOA Maintenance Bldg. Call Buzz McCann @ 530-249-5512 for payment drop-off.
- The crew will then load the bags onto the truck, slit them open and dump the loose material into the bed.
- The old bags will be left in a bundle where found.
