

Free 2020 Community Chipping Program

First Round for the Season

Please do your part...for the safety of your Community.

Again in 2020, the GM curbside chipping program is being subsidized through a Plumas County Fire Safe Council grant program: <https://www.plumasfiresafe.org/community-chipping-program.html>

This means there is most likely no cost to you (see below) to chip the green waste slash material from your annual property maintenance or hazardous fuel reduction work.

First Round of chipping is scheduled:

- **July 6 - 10** – application to be received no later than **June 29, 2020**.

To participate in the free 2019 chipping service:

- **Download the attached PC-FSC GM Chipping Application Form**
 - Fill in the blanks on the first page
 - Review all information on the second page
 - Sign the form
- **Return completed form to GM Chipping Coordinator Judy Clot or GM HOA office**
 - By email to Judy Clot: laketahoeforester@gmail.com

- **Stack your brush, saplings and limbs curbside**
 - Avoid placement on roadway or in roadside drainage
 - Check that materials and piles comply with all page 2 rules (this is very important)
- Due to grant rules each GM owner can select **either free service week but not both**.
- The FREE chipping service is for up to 16 linear feet of material, no more than 12 feet deep and 4 feet high. Any material in excess may be charged to the landowner at a subsidized rate of \$25/quarter hour, which is about the time needed to chip a large pile about the size of a small car.
- The chipping service **cannot include pine needles or pine cones**.

Start your fire fuel hazard and defensible space clean-up now!
